## **Puyallup Elks**

Elks Lodge #1450 in Puyallup was founded in 1922 by three Elks members who were living in the area. They submitted a list of 90 possible charter members to the Grand Lodge. A committee of 13 members was chosen to organize the Lodge, which opened June 10, 1922. In the first year, there were 353 members, who met at the Masonic Temple.

The Lodge constructed and dedicated a new building in 1964, the site where it is now. The beautiful building featured a restaurant, a bar, a large lounge rooms, meeting rooms, tennis court and an outdoor swimming pool with locker rooms. In its heyday, the Lodge hosted many dances, parties, and entertainment events.

Charitable work is always at the heart of everything Elks do. In the fall of the year for over 20 years, the lodge has held a dinner to support therapy for children with disabilities in addition to the regular contributions to the Washington State Therapy Program for Children. The Lodge also visits the Veterans' home and provide scholarships for local students. The Covid pandemic closed the Lodge for the first extended period in its history but they reopened and are now reviving programs for the benefit of the members and the community.

Membership is growing each month.

On June 11, 2022, the Lodge held a Centennial Ball celebrating 100 years of success and are looking forward to what the coming decades hold.
